## What Are Personal Pronouns & Why They Matter

Some common pronouns!*				
they	them	their	theirs	themselves
she	her	her	hers	her
he	him	his	his	himself
ze	hir	hir	hirs	hirself
ze	zim	zir	zirs	zirself

<sup>\*</sup>This pronoun list is not exhaustive.

- → Pronouns replace a person's name when speaking about them.
- → It is good practice to ask which pronouns a person uses.
  It is *not* good practice to assume someone's pronouns.
- → If you do not know/have not asked someone's pronouns, try to use "they/ them" pronouns or their name..
- → RESPECT!
