General Student Agreement

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing educational programs in the secondary schools listed below and are continuing their education at Morrisville State College.

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds on past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction. Specific articulation provisions are listed with each course.

Specific Articulation Provisions

In order to receive Morrisville State College Equine Science credit, the responsible Equine instructor (or designee) from each local BOCES agrees to:

1. Sign a "Certified Teacher Recommendation for College Credit" verifying the student's proficiency;
2. Submit the student's transcripts; and
3. The appropriate BOCES' "Employability Profile in Horse Care and Handling" (or its equivalent)

BOCES will provide Morrisville State College with a copy of their curriculum outline in Horse Care and Handling (first and second year sequence where applicable).

Morrisville State College will grant credit whenever the student officially matriculates into one of the following curriculums and meets the criteria listed below:

Equine Science and Management (AAS)


Equine Racing and Management (AAS)

- Students must receive a grade of 80% or better in the BOCES' Equine Science Program




- Students completing the one (1) year of a New York State BOCES' Equine Science Program will be granted two (2) credit hours of ESCI 100 – Horse Husbandry. BOCES programs offering a full two (2) years sequence will be granted (1) additional credit for ESCI 100 – Horse Husbandry, totaling three (3) credits for the entire two year sequence.
- The student understands that he/she must complete the first semester of course work with a grade of 2.25 or better, while carrying a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours at Morrisville State College, before articulation credit is posted on the transcript.
- Upon acceptance to Morrisville State College, the student should contact his/her high school/BOCES guidance department to facilitate the granting of credit.
- This agreement will be reviewed annually by the Morrisville State College Equine Department and the BOCES Equine Science Department.
- This agreement will be in effect upon signing by both parties and may be revised by mutual agreement of both parties.


