## Stein, Pierre-Louis named All-Conference for soccer

Morrisville State College men's soccer players, Andrew Stein (Oswego, NY) and Sanley Pierre-Louis (Nyack, NY) have been named to the North Eastern Athletic Conference (NEAC) men's soccer all-conference teams following the 2009 season.

Stein, named to the second team, led Morrisville State

in scoring this season, netting five goals and tallied three assists for the Mustangs. Four of his scores came off penalty kick opportunities.

Stein ranked in the top ten in four categories in overall statistical leaders in the NEAC, eighth in points (13), tenth in points per game (0.87), tied for sixth in goals scored (5) and tied for eighth in goals per game (0.33).

The sophomore is majoring in business administration at Morrisville State College and is the son of Phyllis and Robert Stein of Oswego.



Pierre-Louis was named to the third team following his performance on the field this season. Pierre-Louis was second on the team in scoring, netting five goals for 10 team points, ranking him in the top ten in three categories in overall statistical leaders: eighth in points per game (1.0), tied for sixth in goals scored (5), and fifth in goals per game (0.5).

Britton earned first team honors following a record breaking season for the Mustangs. In 97 games played she tallied 343 kills, 21 assists, 30 service aces, 304 defensive digs, and 22.5 blocks, leading Morrisville State to a 13 win season.



Britton led the Mustangs on the floor in kills, service aces, defensive digs and was second in hitting percentage and third in blocks. She was named the NEAC Athlete of the Week twice this season, ranking fourth in hitting percentage in the conference overall statistics, second in kills, and eighth in digs.

Britton shattered the hitting records at Morrisville State, recording

374 kills, a .232 hitting percentage.

The 2006 graduate of Cazenovia High School is majoring in early childhood education at Morrisville State. She is the daughter of Janet and Richard Britton of Cazenovia, NY.

Whitfield earned second team honors following a season of dominating play at the net in both hitting and

blocking. In 58 games played, Whitfield tallied 133 kills, 24 assists, 23 service aces, 95 defensive digs and 74 blocks, leading the team in stops at the net and hitting percentage, second in kills and third in digs.

Whitfield led the conference overall statistical leaders in hitting percentage (.318), was eighth in kills, and first in blocks. Passing the all-time leader in blocks at Morrisville State, Whitfield holds the career record in blocks with 246 in three seasons of play, setting the season record in 2008 with 106.

The 2004 Benton Harbor High graduate is majoring in accounting at Morrisville State. She is the daughter of Cathy and Larry Cohn of Benton Harbor, Michigan.



## Hunt seat equine team Sunday Show Champion

Morrisville State College hosted two Intercollegiate Horse Show Association (IHSA) competitions over the weekend at the barn on Fearon Road, and rode the way to show champion honors on Sunday, topping all competition with 43 team points.

On Saturday, six riders placed in the top two in their respective classes compiling 18 team points for Morrisville State.

Chelsea Stanbro (Buffalo, NY) and Karli Wimmer (Brackney, PA) each rode to first place finishes in their respective classes, Stanbro in the intermediate equitation over fences and Wimmer in the advanced walk trot canter class.

Katie Northrop (Brighton, NY) placed second in the novice equitation over fences and novice flat class, while teammate Jill Featherly (Hilton, NY) also collected a second place finish in the novice over fences class.

Renee Petruzelli (Clifton Springs, NY) was second in the advanced walk trot canter class and Kathryn Galyon (Pearl River, NY) second in the beginner walk trot canter class.

In Sunday's competition, Morrisville State placed 12 riders in the top two spots to earn show champion honors over
