It is my pleasure to write you on behalf of the Morrisville College Foundation, and introduce you to their plan to expand their facilities.

Our friends at Morrisville State College (MSC) are seeking to expand the Morrisville Equine Institute's 400 horse and 280 student operation to include a rehabilitation and physiology center. The facility will be located in the geographic center of New York State, just up the road from Cornell University's Veterinarian School. I have just learned that it has the potential to offer each of you and your trainers the convenience of an equine pool, Aquaciser/aquatred, Hyperbaric Chamber, Eurociser, and indoor galloping track.

Whether or not you have a thoroughbred in need of low impact aerobic conditioning during post-operative care or enhanced conditioning during the winter months, this facility will enable MSC to create another Baccalaureate degree and turn-out graduates with a specialized knowledge of rehabilitation and strength-conditioning.

Therefore, when MSC President Cross asked me if I would be willing to inform all of you that they are in the early stages of their \$5 million fundraising campaign, I did not hesitate. I have had the pleasure of seeing NYTB Scholarships awarded to MSC students over the years, and I believe you will all agree that they are all doing a great job. Moreover, the benefits their proposed expansion offers to thoroughbred owners in New York is something I personally find very exciting.
