General Student Agreement

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing educational programs in the secondary schools listed below and are continuing their education at SUNY Morrisville.

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds on past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction. Specific articulation provisions are listed with each course.

Specific Articulation Provisions

In order to receive credit at SUNY Morrisville for ANSC 100 Animal Science and Industry (3 credits), the responsible instructor (or designee) from Broome-Tioga BOCES agrees to:

- 1. Provide a letter of recommendation verifying the student's proficiency
- 2. Submit the student's CTE program student record
- 3. Provide SUNY Morrisville with a copy of their curriculum outline for the Animal Science program upon initial agreement and renewal agreements
- 4. To notify SUNY Morrisville in writing of any changes to the Animal Science curriculum

SUNY Morrisville will grant credit whenever the student officially matriculates into one of the following degree programs:

- 1. Agricultural Business, A.A.S.
- 2. Agricultural Science, A.A.S.
- 3. Animal Science-Dairy, A.A.S.
- 4. Equine Racing Management, A.A.S.
- 5. Equine Science and Management, A.A.S.
- 6. Agricultural Business Development, B.B.A.
- 7. Dairy Management, B.Tech.

and meets the following criteria:

1. Students must have a cumulative average of a C (75/100) or better in the Animal Science program at Broome-Tioga BOCES

Credit will be granted after the first semester of matriculation as long as the student has earned a 2.0 cumulative GPA or higher. Upon acceptance to SUNY Morrisville, the student should contact his or her high school counseling department to facilitate the granting of credit.

This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years. This agreement will be in effect upon signing by both parties and may be revised upon mutual agreement of both parties.
