General Student Agreement

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing an educational program at Eastern Suffolk BOCES and intend to continue their education at SUNY Morrisville.

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds on past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction.

Specific Articulation Provisions

Students who have successfully completed either the Auto Body Repair & Car Customizing or Automotive Technology program at Eastern Suffolk BOCES, have participated in a work based learning activity, and have earned a Career Technical Education endorsement between June 2020 and June 2022 will be eligible to earn three (3) credits at SUNY Morrisville for AUTO 110: Summer Work Experience and one (1) credit for AUTO 138: Career Awareness.

In order to receive these credits, the student must provide a copy of his/her BOCES Certificate of Completion which includes the Career Technical Education endorsement, along with a CTE instructor recommendation letter, by the end of the first week of their first semester at SUNY Morrisville. Credit will be awarded upon successful completion of one year of full-time coursework at SUNY Morrisville. Successful completion, in this case, is defined as earning a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better.




