General Student Agreement:

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing educational programs in the secondary schools listed below and are continuing their education at SUNY Morrisville.

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds upon past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction. Specific articulation provisions are listed with each course.

Specific Articulation Provisions:

In order to receive credit from the SUNY Morrisville Environmental Science Department the responsible Aquaculture Instructor (or designee) from the Urban Assembly New York Harbor School agrees to:

- a. Sign a "Certified Teacher Recommendation for College Credit" verifying the student's proficiency.
- b. Submit the student's transcripts.


The Urban Assembly NY Harbor School will provide a copy of their general curriculum outline for CTE Program in Aquaculture. Career and Technical Education is a New York State program of study designed to prepare students for careers and higher education in a wide array of fields that involve technology. At NY Harbor School the CTE programs are geared towards Marine Science and Technology. Approved CTE programs allow students to graduate with a technical endorsement on your high school diploma upon successful completion of NYS graduation requirements and an industry-based technical assessment. SUNY Morrisville agrees to grant credit when the student matriculates into the Aquaculture and Aquatic Science AAS degree program or Environmental and Natural Resource Management Program Bachelors (aquaculture track).

- Students completing the CTE Program in Aquaculture at the NY Harbor School will be granted two credits in NATR 257 and NATR 258 Aquaculture Practicum III and IV.
- Upon acceptance at SUNY Morrisville, the student should contact his or her high school guidance department to facilitate the granting of credit.
- This agreement will be reviewed annually by the SUNY Morrisville Environmental Science Department and the Urban Assembly NY Harbor School.
- This agreement will be in effect upon signing by both parties and may be revised upon mutual agreement of both parties.


