Admission Priorities

The Center's enrollment priorities are as follows:

4. Community Residents

The Center will prioritize applications for siblings of children already enrolled. Center staff will also be given preference should they apply for child care.

Tuition Assistance

SUNY students may be eligible for SUNY Scholarship funding for child care expenses. All families can apply and may be eligible for county subsidies based on their household income and family size. Please see the director for details.

School Age Program

SCHOOL AGE PROGRAM:

Care is offered before school, after school (afternoon snack included), Holidays (excluding New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Columbus Day, Thanksgiving and the day after, the week between Christmas and New Year's Day, and also Martin Luther King, Jr. Day), Conference Days and regularly scheduled school closings. No care is offered on closings due to inclement weather or emergencies. Morning program will follow the school delays (either opening an hour or two hours later). During full day programs breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack are provided. School year programs are operated at the Edward R. Andrews Elementary School on Eaton Street and children must live in the Morrisville-Eaton district in order to participate in the program. Summer Programs are open to non-district residents.
