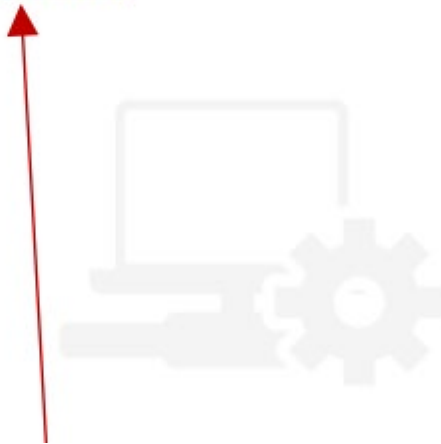

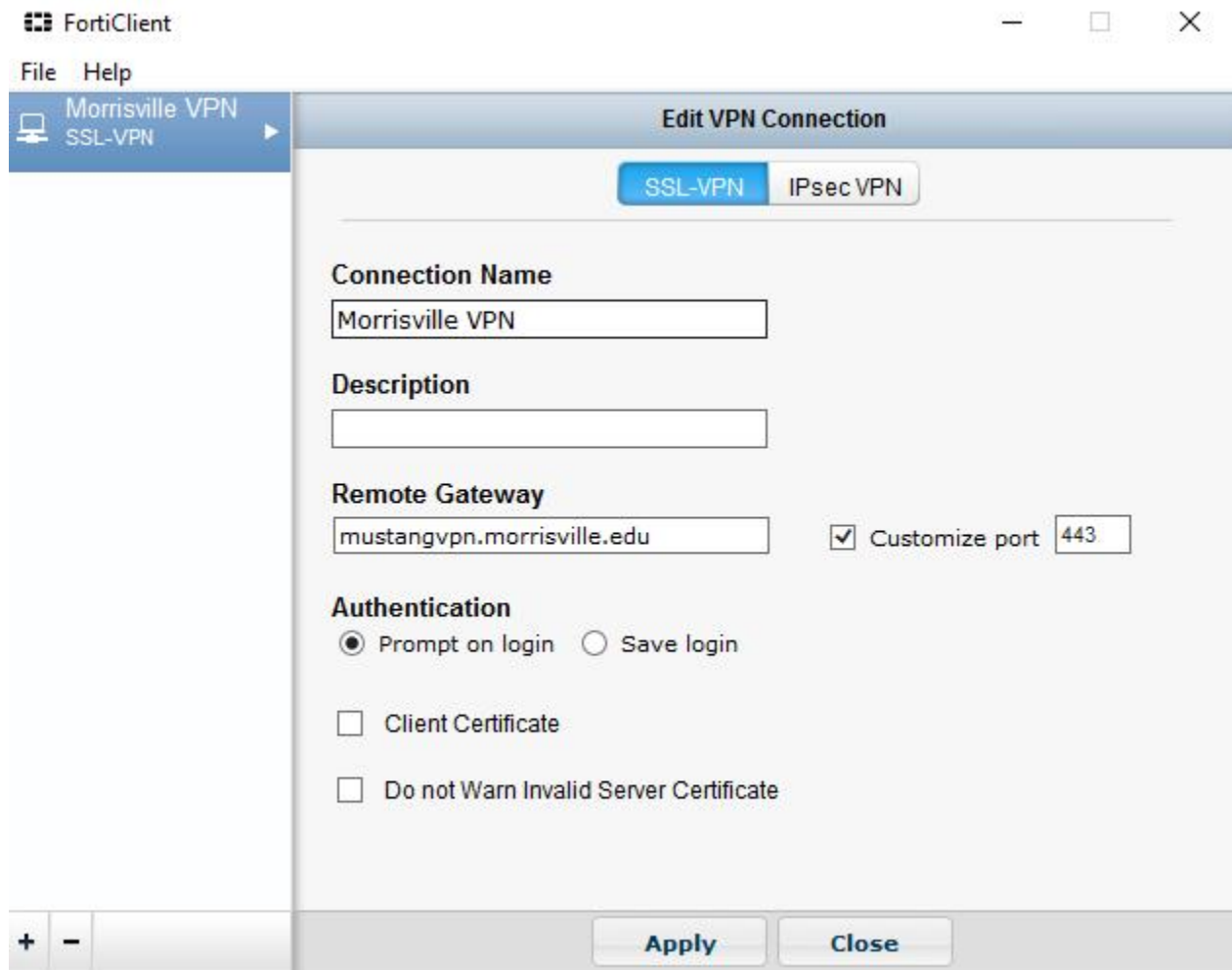




You will be prompted to fill out settings. Below is what you should have as the settings.
