

Financial Aid Calendar

October:

As of October 1, the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and New York State Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) applications are available for the upcoming 2019-2020 academic year.

- If you do not already have an FSA ID, obtain one at the Federal Student Aid web site (www.fsaaid.ed.gov) one for the student and one for the parent of a dependent student.
- Check the Financial Aid-How to Apply located on our website (<https://www.morrisville.edu/financial-aid/how-apply-aid>) for suggested documents needed to complete the applications

November:

SUNY Morrisville recommends you file your FAFSA as soon as possible to be considered for all available aid.

New York State residents who have filed a FAFSA will receive information with instructions to complete the TAP application (www.tapweb.org)

If you have been accepted to SUNY Morrisville and completed all required documentation, you will receive an award notice from SUNY Morrisville directing you to log-in to your web for students to view your award.

December:

SUNY Morrisville will send e-mail notification if you have any outstanding requirements/documents that prevent financial aid from processing. These reminders will continue to be sent until all items have been received/satisfied.

March-August:

You will be contacted with instructions on how to apply for your student and parent federal loans.

July:

If all documents and applications are in order, your financial aid should appear on your billing statement. If not, contact SUNY Morrisville Financial Aid Office (finaid@morrisville.edu)

The Student Accounts Office will notify students by e-mail that their billing statement is available online. If you have not received notification, you should contact SUNY Morrisville Student Accounts Office.

Arrange payment plans with Student Accounts for any balance due.

August:

All financial aid processing should be complete.
